MEETING MINUTES

Attendance: Dr. Nguyen-Trung Hieu, Chair; Suchitra Surapiboonchai; Poxie Xumsai; Raj Mago; Prem Lalvani; Sadruddin Noorani; Lourdes Mon; Martino Tangkar; Jaz Park (representing Kay Rho); CW Chan.

I. Call to order

• A quorum was present and the Chair called meeting to order at 7:00 PM.

II. Approval of minutes

• Moved by Lalvani and seconded by Noorani; June 26th Minutes were approved with names and typos correction.

III. Focus discussion on board membership policies

- Dr. Hieu presented framework of board and advisory board membership with specified term duration but no term limit, as well as causes for expulsion.
- Discussion:
 - 1) Board eligibility should include past annual dinner chairs and Asian Fest chairs, but not forum chairs;
 - 2) Advisory board membership should include retired board members;
 - 3) Each term should be less than the originally proposed 4 year-term;
 - 4) Each community should have at least one board member; no max;
 - 5) Expulsion cause can remain but should require 2/3 vote of full membership;
 - 6) Effective date to be specified.
 - 7) Dr. Hieu will take the above understandings to the By-laws committee to work out a final format for vote for By-laws amendment.

IV. Other discussions

- Dr. Hieu reported he was invited to the Mayor's press event for the Argyle Red-Line Upgrade completion. It was a clear pay-off of AACC's outreach and recent meeting with the mayor. It signified the importance of building relationship which should be an important component of future AACC agenda.
- Dr. Hieu proposed the establishment of AACC liaisons to various elected officials on city, county, state as well as federal levels.
- Members endorsed the concept and suggested term duration should be specified.

- Dr. Hieu thanked the Board for allowing him to envision and carry out AACC vision and mission.

- 2nd AACC Planning Committee meeting is Oct. 24th at same place and time (Hyatt@6:30pm).
- CW Chan reported CMAP (Chicago Metropolitan Agency for Planning), an agency established by state legislature to coordinate planning of the Northern Illinois region, had just approved a request by CBCAC (Coalition for a Better Chinese American Community) to provide technical assistance in the amount equivalent to \$600,000+ to conduct a comprehensive plan of Chinatown. He invited other communities to use this as a model for other AA communities.
- On behalf of the Board, Dr. Hieu congratulated Mr. Chan and Chinese Community on the CBCAC's significant technical assistance in-kind award (\$600,000+). This is truly a model for other AA communities.

- Dr. Hieu thanked everyone for coming and adjourned the meeting at 8:15 p.m. Board members were invited to a dinner after meeting.
